2020-2021: Highlights of a Year of Reflection

Our Region was hit hard by both the 2020 Spring Flood, COVID-19 Pandemic, and economic downturn. As a resilient community service provider, CFWB remained open to serve our business community throughout the year.

CFWB participated in the Wood Buffalo 2020 Business & Economic Recovery Plan which was a collaborative effort to engage the business community and recommend programs and support services to help businesses recover. Using the recommendations from the Task Force, key business support organizations have partnered to create a community-led Plan. The organizations included: Community Futures Wood Buffalo, Fort McMurray Chamber of Commerce, Fort McMurray Construction Association, Northeastern Alberta Aboriginal Business Association, and Fort McMurray Wood Buffalo Economic Development and Tourism. The Business and economic recovery occurred in stages consisting of immediate, short-term, and long-term actions.

Community Futures Wood Buffalo assisted as called upon to do. We worked in partnership with FMWBEDT to apply for funding from the Federal Government, and also from them for the launch of the Business Support/Business Coaching Program.

Over 117 Businesses participated in both the Coaching and Professional Services and Business Support Programs, which enabled them to obtain professional services (Accounting/Marketing/Social-Media/Legal/Human Resources) and pivot their business.

This program was so successful! Businesses accessed in excess of \$3.5MM in Employee Wage and Rental Subsidies, remain operational, and did not close their businesses.

Many business owners came to our office as a place of solace, for a coffee, support, just to say hello, needing Lending services, Coaching, and Business Support services. We processed well over a hundred loans through the Regional Relief and Recovery Loan Fund which provided much needed cash flow to our local area businesses.

Community Futures Wood Buffalo continued building new relationships, most notably with the Wood Buffalo Arts Council. We are planning to deliver two sets of training specifically geared towards artists. The "Artrepreneur" Series", will be launched in Spring 2021.

It is a six-week, bi-annual training platform which is geared towards start-up businesses. Our Partner, Project Gazelle will compliment this new relationship with Wood Buffalo Arts Council in the delivery of the workshops.

This is a fantastic opportunity which extends CFWB's reach for start-up businesses in our local ecosystem and includes over 300 Artists in our region.
